The Nittany Youth wrestling camp is designed to provide high-end wrestling instruction for the young wrestler coupled with fun, team/character building activities appropriate for the elementary to early secondary school age group. Wrestling "citizenship" is encouraged. Intracamp teams are formed that cut across age and geographic differences. The Nittany Youth wrestlers learn to work as a team with older wrestlers especially challenged to show their leadership capabilities.

Wrestlers are to bring brown bag lunches and a morning snack each day. (We will let you know the date of any special lunch events in advance.)
